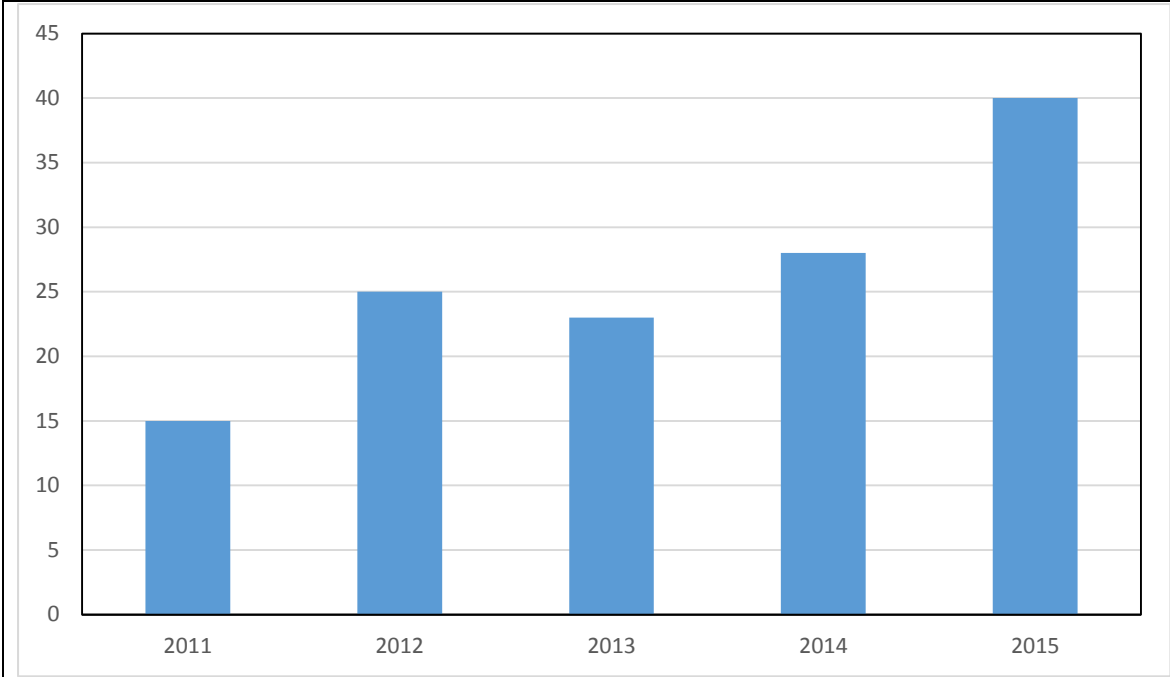

THE HIPPOCRATIC OATH.

There was a time when people believed that the illness was caused by the anger of the gods or evil spirits. This was the medical tradition into which Hippocrates was born around 460 b c. His birth place was the Isle of Cos in Greece. Hippocrates learnt the traditional methods of healing from his father, a doctor, who practiced medicine at the shrine of Asclepine. But Hippocrates believed and taught his own pupils that illness was due to natural causes. Changes in the environment or weather or changes in the human body caused illness. That is why Hippocrates is called Father of Modern Medicine.

However, Hippocrates did not openly disagree with his father who was his teacher. But he impressed upon the minds of his pupils that a patient must be carefully and thoroughly examined in order to diagnose his illness .Treatment should be given only after the diagnosis. This is the practice followed by the doctors today. Hippocrates also taught his pupils to keep a day to day records of a patient's progress and the treatment given. The bed head ticket in our hospital today may have started with this practice.

Besides this, Hippocrates is also remembered for another very special reason .During his long career, as a teacher of medicine , he laid rules to guide his pupils' moral conduct. In times, these rules evolved into a code known as Hippocratic Oath. Even today doctors honour this code. You may see it displayed in a doctor's consultation room.

The Hippocratic Oath, even after centuries, continues to make medicine profession respected in all parts of the world.
