
STREET MARKETS

Street markets and street sellers have become a common sight in Sir Lanka. They are found everywhere, in cities and their suburbs. Wherever you go, street sellers are a common sight. They sell vegetables, fruits, sweets and ornaments. Some even sell cloth and clothes. We are used to buying our provisions from the fair once a week.
